👑 God the Father – The Source of All Fatherhood






- ❤️ He is the **father** who **fills** us and **heals** us.
- 😊 He is **compassionate, patient**, and always pursuing His children.
- ✨ The **greatest gift** Jesus gave us was the **privilege to call God Father.**



🩸 Jesus as the Crimson Worm (Tola)

- ✝️ On the cross, Jesus began all his prayers with **"Father"** and ended with **"Father,"** but in the middle He cried, **"My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"** (Psalm 22:1)
- 😞 Because of the weight of all our sin and shame that He carried, He couldn't call **Father.**
- ☹️ Jesus was despised, rejected, and beaten.
- 👁️ When Pontius Pilate said, **"Behold the man,"** it was because He was marred beyond recognition.
- 🙌 He willingly took the reproach of humanity upon Himself.
- 📖 And Jesus prophetically said, **I am a worm and not a man.** He was pointing to (Psalm 22:6)
- 🐛 Here the word used for the worm is the Hebrew word **"Tola" (crimson worm).**
- 🩸 **The crimson worm:**
- 🥚 Only lays eggs once in its lifetime.
- 🌳 When it is time, it climbs a tree willingly.
- 🪵 Attaches itself permanently to the wood and forms a crimson coloured shell that sticks to the wood.
- 🐣 Gives life to its offspring and the children feed on the living mother for **3 days.**
- 🍖 Then it gives up its life.
- 🩸 It stains the wood with crimson blood red substance.
- 💔 The only way for its children to live was it to die.





I am a worm and not a man.







-  **Jesus willingly** went to the cross and **shed His blood**.
-  He **gave His life** so humanity could live.
-  Jesus became forsaken so we could call God **"Abba Father."**


-  **Call unto our Abba Father loudly.**
-  Religious people and people who live on their own terms cannot call Him **"Abba Father."**
-  Opposite of this is the example of the **Tower of Babel**, when tried to build with their own strength.
-  But one confusion from heaven brought it down.
-  Call unto your **Abba Father**, and every confusion leaves.









-  **Bartimaeus** - He cried out till he got **Jesus' attention**.
-  Your cry is not in vain. He will give you the attention.




Why do we need to know the Father?

-  Peter's revelation of Jesus that He is **Jesus Christ, the Son of the living God**, came from the Father.
-  There are revelations about God, about your life, only the **Father** can reveal it to you.
-  Once it was revealed **Simon** was changed to **Peter**.
-  There are glory realms, your purpose on earth, that **only Father can reveal** to you.

-  **Bartimaeus** threw away his blind beggar's garment before he ran to Jesus.
-  When you come to the presence of Jesus, **throw away your old clothes**.
-  Once you throw off your blind clothes and **call out to Jesus, your realms will change**.
-  Because his realms changed, the Bible scholars believe that Bartimaeus was one of the people who were there in the **Upper room along with 120**.
-  You don't have to have **FOMO - Fear of Missing Out**.
-  **Do not fear** that you will miss out on what God has kept for you, whether it's **revival, or prosperity or healing**.

 ***For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." (Romans 8:15)***

-  When the **prodigal son** came back to the Father's house, the lost smile came back.
-  The **Father** will **restore the joy** that you lost.
-  Not only the smile, the **Father** gave him back the **dance** that he once danced.
-  Your **royal robe** of righteousness will come back.
-  Your **ring of authority** will come back.
-  Your **shoes of destiny** will come back.
-  Along with that Father has also kept something which you don't know, which he will give it to you.
-  God will give you a **big fatted calf, immeasurable wealth** he has kept for you.

-  **Our God is a wealthy God** - He owns everything. (**Psalm 50:10**)
-  May you meet the God who is wealthy - **the glory realm**.
-  Follow God and follow His plan, and He shall give you **immeasurable wealth**.

- 🙏 **Being a father is not just a role; it is a divine privilege.**
- 👩 Mothers naturally bond with the children first because of pregnancy and nurturing.
- 👨 Fathers may initially feel distant or emotionally disconnected.
- 🙏 So, mothers should bring the children close to the fathers to receive the **father's blessing**.
- ✨ The word used for a **father's blessing** means - **the permission and the authorization to prosper.**
- 👂 Mothers should teach the children never to speak against the fathers.
- 🙌 The fathers should always release the **blessing** upon the children.
- ☀️ This **blessing touches** and **authorises the ones who value** it.

- 🐷 The prodigal son went to a pig sty when he left father's house.
- 🏠 **Every problem starts when you leave the father's house.**
- ⚠️ Every time you move out of your father's house, there is a curse activated over your life - **a spirit of failure.**
- 🏠 But when you come back to the father's house, **God will authorise you to prosper.**
- 🌟 All these realms open when you are **close to your daddy.**

- 🙌 A father's **consent without a blessing** will not authorise you to prosper.
- 📖 The prodigal son got the consent, but the blessing was not there.
- 🔄 If you are going into nothingness where you should have prospered, recognise and correct your standing with your fatherly figures and the **breakthrough will come.**

? What should you do as a father?

- 👤 A father must:
 - 🛡️ **Protect**
 - 🧭 **Lead**
 - 📖 **Provide**
 - 💡 **Inspire**
 - 🙏 **Pray as priest for the family**
 - 👑 **Rule over every darkness against the family as a King**
 - 📖 **Speak God's word as a prophet.**

👤 **Always be humble and get the blessing from your father.**

🙏 What you should never give to your father:

1. 👤 **Do not give your foolishness to your father** (*Proverbs 17:21, Proverbs 17:25*)
 - 💖 Your father's greatest happiness is to see a **wise son/daughter.**
2. ❤️ **Do not mistreat your father** (*Proverbs 19:26, Proverbs 28:24*)
 - 💰 Never steal money from them.
 - 👤 Ask them **forgiveness** if you have done so, so that **God can prosper you.**

3. ⚠️ **Do not curse your father** (*Proverbs 20:20*)
 - 🕯️ When you are in the worst time of your life, **your lamp will be put out**, if you curse your father.
 - 🛡️ **Do not keep silent** when someone speaks against your spiritual father.
 - 😞 Peter was part of the group who put Jesus down, before he denied Jesus.
 - 📖 The Hebrew word for **curse** means - **to despise, to hate, to make light of him.**
 - 🚫 **Never make your father small.**
 - 👨 **Never be part of the generation that curses its father** (*Proverbs 30:11*)

4. 🗨️ **Do not be in the companion of gluttons** (*Proverbs 28:7*)
 - ⚡ The Hebrew word means somebody with **loose morals, of bad character**, someone who associates with a **worldly person.**
 - 👥 **Be careful about your company.**
 - 📖 Acts 21, speaks about **Philip** - The only person the Bible calls an evangelist.
 - 🔥 The Holy Spirit speaks there: **Philip** had four daughters who were virgins and prophesied. They were **morally correct.**
 - 🌍 Even if you are a big shot outside, there is no point if you are a failure in the family.
 - ✨ Nothing is more important than making them **spiritually correct before God.**

5. 😡 **Do not mock your father** (*Proverbs 30:17*)
 - 🦅 The ravens of the valley will pick it out and the young eagles eat it.
 - 🗑️ It just flew away, and no one knows what happened. It has lost its direction.
 - 👁️ **Mocking your father causes you to lose direction in every area of life.**





👏 What to Give to Your Father?



1. 👂 **Listen to him** (*Proverbs 1:8, Proverbs 4:1*)
 - 📖 **Your father is a prophet** whom God has kept over you.
 - ✨ If you **pay attention** to your father, if you listen to him, there is a **blessing** in that.
 - 🎯 **Listen to your father** even if it is something you don't like to hear. (*Proverbs 23:22*)
 - ⚖️ Do not put your father's direction and counsel in the same category as your friends'.
 - 👥 You may have many friends, but you have only **one father.** (*1 Corinthians 4:15*)
 - 🎁 If you can value, honor, and listen to your father's voice, that is the **marvelous gift** you can give him.



2. 🧠 **Give him your wisdom** (*Proverbs 15:20*)
 - 🎨 Give him your talent, your **skill set**, your **intelligence**, and your **skillfulness.**
 - 🌱 God has given skill and talent to everyone — **develop it and give it to your father.**

What Should Fathers Do?





From the life of Abraham:

-  You should **win over your personal battles**.
-  Abraham had to fight his battles to see his promise fulfilled, but he **never quit on God**.
-  He kept building altars and worshipping God to the point that **God could not refuse him**.
-  **Shout unto God** in a way that He cannot refuse you.







-  Sometimes, the battle might be because of addictions or finances.
-  If you do not gain victory over it, it will carry on to your generations, and **your children will have to fight it**.

-  **Jesus** came through the genealogy of Abraham.
-  If Abraham had given up in his battle, **Jesus** would not have been able to reveal Himself the way He should.

From the life of Joseph (*the foster father of Jesus*):

-  **Fathers protect**.
-  When he knew Mary was pregnant, he resolved to put her away secretly.
-  **Never put your wife to shame**, and **never compromise your wife's dignity**.
-  **Protect your wife and children** for certain **blessings** to come upon you.

From the life of Elijah:

-  Even though Elijah was not Elisha's biological father, he imparted a **double portion**.
-  He was not scared of his son becoming greater than him.
-  **If one generation does not impart, the next generation will fall behind**.
-  **The lesser is blessed by the greater. (Hebrews 7:7)**
-  You, as a father, should **impart what you have** to the next generation.
-  **God will bless the next generation** because of your faithfulness.
